

# **Exhaust Fan Operations**

### **PURPOSE**


This document provides information for troubleshooting projection exhaust issues, shut offs, etc. that affect Sight and Sound.

## **VERIFYING ISSUES AND TROUBLESHOOTING**

- 1. Verify that the issue is exhaust related.
  - Christie projector exhaust issues are signified by an "Extractor fan interlock" error on the TPC.



- **Sony** projector exhaust issues are signified by "temperature" and "exhaust" errors on the projector controls.
  - a. **Navigate** to Menu > Status > Temperature to identify a temperature error on the enclosure.



b. Click on the Alert icon (circled) to identify exhaust alerts on the Alert Messages screen.



- 2. **Check** projector for airflow:
  - a. **Ensure** projector is turned off and bulb has cooled for at least 15 minutes.
  - b. **Open** the projector lamp house and feel for significant upward pull of airflow. Lack of airflow likely means that the exhaust is offline.
- 3. **Check** the circuit breaker for the exhaust system in the electrical panel. These are usually marked "exhaust" as well as "rocker switch."
  - Check the auditorium's gray circuit breaker box to identify a tripped exhaust circuit breaker
  - **Locate** the rocker switch adjacent to the circuit breaker box and **flip** the switch to the off position.
  - Reset the tripped breaker in the breaker box.
  - Flip the rocker switch back on.
  - **Escalate** to your HVAC provider if the breaker trips again or will not stay in the ON position.



### **CHANGING EXHAUST FAN BELTS**

- 1. **Turn** off power to the fan motor via a switch located next to the motor. If no switch is present, **turn off** the exhaust power breaker in booth.
- 2. Remove the cover fan.
- 3. Visually inspect the fan belt.
  - Replace the fan belt if broken. Restore power to the fan and replace the fan cover.
  - b. **Replace** the fan cover and **request service** from the HVAC provider if the fan belt is not broken.

## ASSEMBLING AND ORDERING MUSHROOM FANS

- 1. **Disconnect** the exhaust vent tube from the top of the projector.
- 2. **Connect** the booster fan to the top of the projector in place of the vent tube.
- 3. Plug in and power on the booster fan.
- 4. **Ensure** the airflow is pulling air out of the projector.
- 5. **Leave** device in place until the exhaust system is repaired.
- 6. **Order** spare replacement fans as needed from Cinema Solutions.
  - a. "8IN Proj FAN KIT F8"
